Young Scientist Awards

The EFP offers Young Scientist Awards (YSA) to stimulate young parasitologists and thus contribute to the advancement of parasitological research in Europe. (https://www.eurofedpar.eu/efp-awards-scholarships/)

At EMOP XIV, up to three prizes will be awarded for original research work in parasitology (500 € each). Prizes also include a diploma and a refund of the EMOP registration fees.

Candidates must be less than 35 years old and be members of an EFP member society (https://www.eurofedpar.eu/member-societies/) members of suspended societies cannot apply.

The paper must be <u>first-authored</u> by the candidate and presented in oral form at EMOP XIV. The research must have been based at an institution of an EFP member country.

How to apply:

The following documents must be submitted:

- 1. The completed application form, signed by the candidate and the head of the department where the research was done.
- 2. A short manuscript (of three pages plus references) describing the work. The manuscript should not have been published before and is only for the information of the jury. The candidate should be the first author of the manuscript.
- 3. Proof of registration for the congress. At registration, the EMOP organizers should be informed of the intention to apply for the award.
- 4. Proof of age (e.g. ID, passport) and society membership, and a short curriculum vitae (one page).

The paper will be <u>orally presented (15 min) by the candidate</u> in a special session organized during EMOP XIV. This condition is mandatory for the award selection.
